

Athletes with Disabilities Program

The Bank of America Shamrock Shuffle 8K strives to provide accessibility for all athletes with disabilities through our Athletes with Disabilities Program. This program is open to all athletes with a permanent physical disability. When completing the registration process, participants are asked if they need Health & Fitness Expo and/or race day services and accommodations. Anyone who answers yes to this question, will be contacted by the event's Athletes with Disabilities Coordinator who will work directly with the participant to ensure they are in the program and that their specific needs are addressed.

Wheelchair Division

Wheelchair athletes may compete in the Bank of America Shamrock Shuffle 8K with push rim or manual wheelchairs. Awards are given to the top three male and female finishers.

Wheelchair athletes are provided an offsite meeting point and escorted by bike marshals to the course start line where they will start 2 – 3 minutes ahead of the participant field.

Ambulatory Disabilities

Athletes with Disabilities who are ambulatory, including those who are Visually Impaired, Hearing Impaired, Amputees and those with other special needs will be offered accommodations including guide runners, as needed at the Health & Fitness Expo and for race day. Ambulatory athletes with disabilities may start in the Athletes with Disabilities Start Corral or in a regularly assigned start corral.
